Building Permit & Pet Registration are required. Call City Hall for more info.

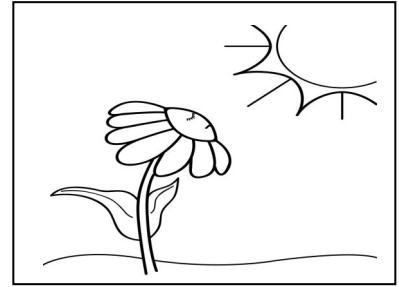
Mowing Season Please do not mow/throw cut grass into the city street because it plugs up the storm sewers when it rains. It also makes the streets slippery when wet for cyclist.

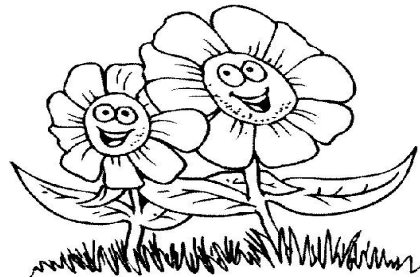

GARBAGE & RECYCLING

City Garbage Bags (50 cents each) and tags can be purchased at City Hall, Livermore Fastway & Sweet Water Spirits.

Extra Garbage Bags: To have more than 1 bag/week picked up, you need to purchase orange tags for \$1.50 each and place on your extra bag.

Yard Waste Tags are 50 cents each.

Please refrain from putting your garbage out on the curb more than 12 hours before your pick up time. Be courteous to your neighbors and make sure nothing blows into their yard.

Garbage Recycling/Utility Rate by 1%(\$.12) and dumpster fees will increase to \$40. per month. Extra dump fees will be \$20. Effective on July 1 billing.

Streamline Recycling requires:

No trash, plastic bags, Styrofoam or Hazardous materials! Put Glass in designated box. Heavy cardboard should be broken down and placed on the east wall. For large cardboard loads, contact the City, so we can place it directly into the trailer. Remaining recyclables can be placed behind the fence. Please rinse before recycling.

Thank you to those who recycle and keep our City looking great! Things considered "trash", "junk", within the recycling center is an ongoing problem. There are proper ways to dispose of items. If we continue to have issues, we will have to start reprimanding those who are careless about the rules.

Hazardous materials can be taken to Fort Dodge, call 515-576-5866.

City Hall Accepts utility payments by cash, check, ACH, credit or debit card. Cash, check or ACH is the most cost effective for you. If interested in automatically withdrawing your utility bill payment from your checking account, please stop by City Hall for more information .

Other option is payment by credit or debit card at www.Allpay.com. Our pay Location Code is "a002qd" = City of Livermore. ALLPAY will charge you a 2.65% fee on top of your city payment amount. This transaction fee goes to Allpay.
